

ORDINANCE 2009-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDNA, TEXAS ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF EDNA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2009 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2010 REVISING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2009. APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF; REVEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said budget was duly held on the 20th, day of August, 2009 and the 3es day of September, 2009 and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard for or against any item therefore; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDNA:

Section 1:

That the budget for the City of Edna, Texas for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2009 ending on September 30, 2010 in words and figures as show therein be, and hereby is finally approved and adopted.

Section 2:

That the budget for the City of Edna, Texas for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2009 ending on September 30, 2010 as shown therein in words and figures indicated as "Revised 2009-2010" in the budget for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2010 as adopted as revised.


Section 3:

This ordinance shall be and remain in full force and in effect from and after its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Edna, Texas.


