ORDINANCE NO. 2011-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDNA, TEXAS ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF EDNA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2011 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2012 REVISING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2011. APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF; REVEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said budget was duly held on the 18th day of August, 2011 and the 15th day of September, 2011 and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard for or against any item therefore; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDNA:

Section 1:

That the budget for the City of Edna, Texas for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2011 ending on September 30, 2012 in words and figures as show therein be, and hereby is finally approved and adopted.

Section 2:

That the budget for the City of Edna, Texas for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2011 ending on September 30, 2012 as shown therein in words and figures indicated as "Revised 2011-2012" in the budget for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2011 and ending September 30, 2012 as adopted as revised.

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-07

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATE AND THE TAX LEVY AND LEVYING
ADVALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF EDNA, TEXAS FOR THE YEAR 2010 REPEALING
ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND
DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Manager has heretofore submitted to the City Council as proposed budget for the revenues of the City affairs hereof, providing complete financial plan for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2011 and ending September 30, 2012 and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDNA,
TEXAS:**

Section 1:

There shall be and is hereby levied for the year 2011 and ordered to be collected a tax of 0.2891 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of the City of Edna, Texas and that said tax so levied shall be distributed and apportioned as follows:

For the payment of operation of the General Fund of the City of Edna, on each one hundred Dollars (\$100.00) worth of property situated within the corporate limits of the City of Edna and subject to taxation, a tax of 0.1232.

For paying bonds and interest and creating a sinking fund for General Obligation Bonds, on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of property situated within the corporate limits of the City of Edna and subject to taxation, a tax of 0.1659.


