7. Discuss and take possible action to consider award of new water main loop from Prihoda Lane to Main Street.
8. Hear concerns from Irvy Stroude regarding areas in her neighborhood.
9. Discuss and take possible action to approve the first reading of City of Edna Ordinance No. 2011-05 (Nuisances).
10. Discuss and take possible action to review and determine the need to prepare a redistricting plan and submission to the Justice Department.
11. Discuss and consider rescheduling the April 21st council meeting to Monday, April 18th.
12. Consider payment of current bills.
